Falmouth Demographics

Town of Falmouth Demographics (Individual Census-Designated Areas/CDAs below)

Overview: As of the [census²](#) of [2000](#), there are 32,660 people, 13,859 households, and 8,980 families residing in the town. The [population density](#) is 285.0/km² (738.2/mi²). There are 20,055 housing units at an average density of 175.0/km² (453.3/mi²). The racial makeup of the town is 93.39% [White](#), 1.82% [Black](#) or [African American](#), 0.51% [Native American](#), 0.92% [Asian](#), 0.02% [Pacific Islander](#), 1.44% from [other races](#), and 1.91% from two or more races. 1.28% of the population is [Hispanic](#) or [Latino](#) of any race. There are 13,859 households out of which 24.2% have children under the age of 18 living with them, 52.0% are [married couples](#) living together, 10.1% have a female householder with no husband present, and 35.2% are non-families. 29.8% of all households are made up of individuals and 14.0% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older. The average household size is 2.30 and the average family size is 2.84.

In the town the population is spread out with 20.7% under the age of 18, 4.8% from 18 to 24, 24.5% from 25 to 44, 27.5% from 45 to 64, and 22.5% who are 65 years of age or older. The median age is 45 years. For every 100 females there are 87.6 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there are 83.9 males.

The median income for a household in the town is \$48,191, and the median income for a family is \$57,422. Males have a median income of \$41,797 versus \$28,867 for females. The [per capita income](#) for the town is \$27,548. 6.9% of the population and 4.5% of families are below the [poverty line](#). Out of the total population, 8.8% of those under the age of 18 and 6.2% of those 65 and older are living below the poverty line.

East Falmouth is located at 41° 33'54" North, 70° 32'60" West (41.565096, -70.549984)¹. According to the United States Census Bureau, the village has a total area of 16.3 km² (6.3 mi²). 14.1 km² (5.4 mi²) of it is land and 2.2 km² (0.8 mi²) of it is water. The total area is 13.38% water. Demographics: As of the census² of 2000, there are 6,615 people, 2,828 households, and 1,923 families

residing in the village. The population density is 468.6/km² (1,214.8/mi²). There are 4,323 housing units at an average density of 306.3/km² (793.9/mi²). The racial makeup of the village is 92.20% White, 2.92% African American, 0.48% Native American, 0.51% Asian, 0.02% Pacific Islander, 1.68% from other races, and 2.19% from two or more races. 1.75% of the population is Hispanic or Latino of any race. There are 2,828 households out of which 24.0% have children under the age of 18 living with them, 51.6% are married couples living together, 12.7% have a female householder with no husband present, and 32.0% are non-families. 27.1% of all households are made up of individuals and 11.6% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older. The average household size is 2.32 and the average family size is 2.79. In the village the population is spread out with 21.5% under the age of 18, 4.7% from 18 to 24, 24.7% from 25 to 44, 26.1% from 45 to 64, and 22.9% who are 65 years of age or older. The median age is 44 years. For every 100 females there are 89.5 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there are 84.3 males. The median income for a household in the village is \$42,788, and the median income for a family is \$48,302. Males have a median income of \$36,884 versus \$26,875 for females. The per capita income for the village is \$24,041. 8.0% of the population and 6.2% of families are below the poverty line. Out of the total population, 12.0% of those under the age of 18 and 4.6% of those 65 and older are living below the poverty line.

NB: Falmouth Village, Hatchville and Waquoit are not census-designated places but are villages within the town of Falmouth. Detailed census information is not available for these three Falmouth villages.

North Falmouth is located at 41° 38'41" North, 70° 37'50" West (41.644588, -70.630447). According to the United States Census Bureau, the village has a total area of 17.3 km² (6.7 mi²). 10.2 km² (4.0 mi²) of it is land and 7.0 km² (2.7 mi²) of it is water. The total area is 40.63% water. Demographics: As of the census of 2000, there are 3,355 people, 1,364 households, and 975 families residing in the village. The population density is 327.9/km² (848.4/mi²). There are 2,393 housing units at an average density of 233.9/km² (605.1/mi²). The racial makeup of the village is 95.95% White, 1.04% African American, 0.15% Native American, 0.83% Asian, 0.00% Pacific Islander, 0.92% from other races, and 1.10% from two or more races. 0.92% of the population is Hispanic or Latino of any race. There are 1,364 households out of which 26.2% have children under the age of 18 living with them, 62.7% are married couples living together, 7.1% have a female householder with no husband present, and 28.5% are non-families. 25.4% of all households are made up of individuals and 12.3% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older. The average household size is 2.37 and the average family size is 2.84. In the village the population is spread out with 20.8% under the age of 18, 4.0% from 18 to 24, 20.7% from 25 to 44, 31.4% from 45 to 64, and 23.0% who are 65 years of age or older. The median age is 48 years. For every 100 females there are 87.3 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there are 85.6 males.

The median income for a household in the village is \$57,841, and the median income for a family is \$74,458. Males have a median income of \$53,125 versus \$35,417 for females. The per capita income for the village is \$31,462. 4.9% of the population and 2.9% of families are below the poverty line. Out of the total population, 8.3% of those under the age of 18 and 2.5% of those 65 and older are living below the poverty line.

Teaticket is located at 41° 33'29" North, 70° 35'13" West (41.557934, -70.586815)¹. According to the United States Census Bureau, the village has a total area of 3.5 km² (1.3 mi²). 2.7 km² (1.0 mi²) of it is land and 0.8 km² (0.3 mi²) of it is water. The total area is 21.64% water. Demographics: As of the census² of 2000, there are 1,907 people, 908 households, and 550 families residing in the village. The population density is 701.2/km² (1,813.6/mi²). There are 1,558 housing units at an average density of 572.9/km² (1,481.7/mi²). The racial makeup of the village is 94.23% White, 1.00% African American, 0.37% Native American, 1.36% Asian, 0.00% Pacific Islander, 1.36% from other races, and 1.68% from two or more races. 1.21% of the population is Hispanic or Latino of any race. There are 908 households out of which 15.4% have children under the age of 18 living with them, 48.0% are married couples living together, 9.9% have a female householder with no husband present, and 39.4% are non-families. 34.4% of all households are made up of individuals and 18.8% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older. The average household size is 2.07 and the average family size is 2.63. In the village the population is spread out with 16.2% under the age of 18, 4.4% from 18 to 24, 19.7% from 25 to 44, 28.7% from 45 to 64, and 31.0% who are 65 years of age or older. The median age is 53 years. For every 100 females there are 77.6 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there are 77.7 males. The median income for a household in the village is \$41,272, and the median income for a family is \$46,705. Males have a median income of \$37,107 versus \$25,642 for females. The per capita income for the village is \$24,008. 5.0% of the population and 3.5% of families are below the poverty line. Out of the total population, 5.8% of those under the age of 18 and 4.8% of those 65 and older are living below the poverty line.

West Falmouth is located at 41° 35'59" North, 70° 38'16" West (41.599628, -70.637812)¹. According to the United States Census Bureau, the village has a total area of 11.4 km² (4.4 mi²). 8.2 km² (3.2 mi²) of it is land and 3.2 km² (1.2 mi²) of it is water. The total area is 28.18% water. Demographics: As of the census² of 2000, there are 1,867 people, 835 households, and 558 families residing in the village. The population density is 228.1/km² (590.8/mi²). There are 1,278 housing units at an average density of 156.2/km² (404.4/mi²). The racial makeup of the village is 97.86% White, 0.43% African American, 0.05% Native American, 0.70% Asian, 0.00% Pacific Islander, 0.32% from other races, and 0.64% from two or more races. 0.86% of the population are Hispanic or Latino of any race. There are 835 households out of which 19.6% have children under the age of 18 living with them, 58.9% are married

couples living together, 7.1% have a female householder with no husband present, and 33.1% are non-families. 27.9% of all households are made up of individuals and 12.5% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older. The average household size is 2.21 and the average family size is 2.66. In the village the population is spread out with 17.5% under the age of 18, 3.6% from 18 to 24, 20.3% from 25 to 44, 34.2% from 45 to 64, and 24.4% who are 65 years of age or older. The median age is 50 years. For every 100 females there are 88.4 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there are 84.6 males. The median income for a household in the village is \$72,703, and the median income for a family is \$84,368. Males have a median income of \$56,250 versus \$42,250 for females. The per capita income for the village is \$42,159. 2.1% of the population and 0.0% of families are below the poverty line. Out of the total population, 0.0% of those under the age of 18 and 0.0% of those 65 and older are living below the poverty line.

Woods Hole is located at 41° 31'36" North, 70° 39'47" West (41.526730, -70.663184)¹. According to the United States Census Bureau, the village has a total area of 10.0 km² (3.9 mi²). 5.6 km² (2.2 mi²) of it is land and 4.5 km² (1.7 mi²) of it is water. The total area is 44.33% water. Demographics: As of the census² of 2000, there are 925 people, 459 households, and 212 families residing in the village. The population density is 165.3/km² (427.9/mi²). There are 942 housing units at an average density of 168.4/km² (435.8/mi²). The racial makeup of the village is 94.70% White, 1.62% African American, 0.54% Native American, 1.84% Asian, 0.00% Pacific Islander, 0.22% from other races, and 1.08% from two or more races. 0.97% of the population is Hispanic or Latino of any race. Of the 459 households, 14.8% have children under the age of 18 living with them, 39.7% are married couples living together, 5.4% have a female householder with no husband present, and 53.6% are non-families. 40.5% of all households are made up of individuals and 17.9% have someone living alone who is 65 years of age or older. The average household size is 1.94 and the average family size is 2.58. In the village, the age of the population is spread out, with 13.5% under the age of 18, 7.1% from 18 to 24, 25.7% from 25 to 44, 26.4% from 45 to 64, and 27.2% who are 65 years of age or older. The median age is 48 years. For every 100 females, there are 94.7 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there are 88.7 males. The median income for a household in the village is \$47,604, and the median income for a family is \$57,969. Males have a median income of \$31,964 versus \$31,875 for females. The per capita income for the village is \$30,752. 5.3% of the population and 0.0% of families are below the poverty line. Out of the total population, 0.0% of those under the age of 18 and 6.4% of those 65 and older are living below the poverty line.
