WOODS HOLE – VILLAGE OF DISCOVERY

- Walking tour of Woods Hole's art galleries, gift shops and clothing stores
- Step back in time at *Woods Hole Historical Museum* featuring Bradley House Art Gallery, Yale Workshop: 19th Century Renaissance and The Small Boat Museum
- Take a group photo at historic *Nobska Lighthouse* and enjoy the cliff paths for magnificent view of Martha's Vineyard and Vineyard Sound.
- Catch the brilliant sunset at beautiful Quissett Harbor on "The Knob"

AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL

- *Falmouth Museums on the Green* featuring colonial gardens, 18th century houses with period furnishings and artifacts, 18th century doctor's office, whaling & maritime exhibit, and history of Falmouth native Kathryn Lee Bates – Author of America the Beautiful. Enjoy walking around the Village Green and past the childhood home of Miss. Bates.
- Tour of *Historic Highfield Hall*: 1878 Queen Anne stick style "summer cottage" on 400 acres named Beebe Woods
- Group photo and tour of historic *Nobska Lighthouse*
- Lunch along historic Main Street
- Afternoon stroll and garden lecture inside tranquil *Spohr Gardens*: 6-acre garden on Oyster Pond featuring 1,000's of blooming flowers, winding paths, and scenic treasurers.
- Scenic drive along Route 28A, stopping at one of several antique shops along the way.
- Evening entertainment featuring theatre, dance and music in one of several performance venues.

EXCITING AND FUN DAY TRIPS!

- **MARTHA'S VINEYARD**: Travel by ferry for a short 35-minute journey to Martha's Vineyard, located just 5 miles off the coast of Cape Cod, featuring 6 diverse Island towns, a beautiful shoreline, and wonderful shops and restaurants.
- **SANDWICH**: Tour of *Heritage Museums & Gardens* in Sandwich, featuring Josiah Lilly Automobile Museum, American History Museum, Cape Cod Baseball League Hall of Fame and Art Museum and the Carousel Rotunda.
- **HYANNIS**: Tour the *John F. Kennedy Hyannis Museum*, a multimedia exhibit designed to open a window on the days JFK spent on Cape Cod; days relaxing with family, days playing football with PT109 buddies, days spent sailing on the ocean to which he was so constantly drawn. Catch a *whale watch* cruise out of beautiful Barnstable Harbor.
- **PROVINCETOWN**: Drive to beautiful Cape Cod National Seashore, climb 252' Pilgrim Monument, explore Provincetown Museum and Cape Cod Light (Highland Lighthouse), afternoon *whale watch* to see Humpback, Finback, Minke and the endangered North Atlantic Right Whales.
- **PLYMOUTH**: Tour *Plimoth Plantation*: a living history village; see the Mayflower II and Plimoth Rock, spend the afternoon on a *whale watch* to see Humpback, Finback, Minke and the endangered North Atlantic Right Whales.
- **NEWPORT**: Tour opulent ocean-side mansions and historic sites such as Astors' Beachwood Mansion and Fort Adams, traverse the 3.5-mile scenic Cliffwalk, and visit dozens of galleries and shops along the many cobblestone wharves.
