AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL - Historic Main Street, Falmouth Village

- [Falmouth Museums on the Green](#) featuring colonial gardens, 18th century houses, 18th century doctor's office, whaling & maritime exhibit, and history of Falmouth native Katharine Lee Bates, Author of America the Beautiful. Enjoy a self-guided or guided walking tour, and jump aboard a trolley tour in the fall.
- Tour the historic mansion called [Highfield Hall & Gardens](#): 1878 Queen Anne stick style "summer cottage" on 300 acres named Beebe Woods with wonderful walking trails and fully restored gardens
- Lunch at one of Falmouth's [restaurants](#) on historic Main Street with food for every palate
- Enjoy the scenic [Coonamessett Farm](#) with many family activities, ice cream stand and general store
- Afternoon stroll and garden lecture inside tranquil [Spohr Gardens](#): 6-acre garden on Oyster Pond featuring 1,000's of blooming flowers, winding paths, and scenic treasurers
- Evening entertainment featuring [theatre, dance and music](#) in one of several performance venues
- Take an afternoon or sunset cruise aboard [Liberte, The Schooner](#)
- Rent a bike and travel along the scenic 10.7 mile [Shining Sea Bikeway](#)
- Learn the connection between John F. Kennedy & the [Oak Grove Cemetery](#) on their guided walking tours

EXCITING & MEMORABLE Day Trips!!!!

- [MARTHA'S VINEYARD](#): Travel by ferry for a short 35-minute journey to Martha's Vineyard, located just 5 miles off the coast of Cape Cod, featuring 6 diverse Island towns, a beautiful shoreline, and wonderful shops and restaurants. Travel on the [Island Queen, Falmouth-Edgartown Ferry](#) or the year-round [Steamship Authority](#)
- [HYANNIS](#): Tour the [John F. Kennedy Hyannis Museum](#), a multimedia exhibit designed to open a window on the days JFK spent on Cape Cod; days relaxing with family, days playing football with PT109 buddies, days spent sailing on the ocean to which he was so constantly drawn. Join [Hyannis Whale Watcher](#) for a whale watch or dinner cruise out of Barnstable Harbor
- [SANDWICH](#): Tour of [Heritage Museums & Gardens](#) in Sandwich, featuring Josiah Lilly Automobile Museum, American History Museum, Cape Cod Baseball League Hall of Fame and Art Museum and the Carousel Rotunda
- [PROVINCETOWN](#): Drive to beautiful Cape Cod National Seashore, climb 252' Pilgrim Monument, explore Provincetown Museum and Cape Cod Light (Highland Lighthouse), afternoon whale watch [aboard the Dolphin Fleet](#) to see Humpback, Finback, Minke and the endangered North Atlantic Right Whales
- [PLYMOUTH](#): Tour [Plimoth Plantation](#): a living history village; see the Mayflower II and Plimoth Rock, spend the afternoon fishing or whale watching aboard [Capt. John Boats](#)
- [NEWPORT](#): Tour opulent ocean-side mansions and historic sites such as Astors' Beachwood Mansion and Fort Adams, traverse the 3.5-mile scenic Cliffwalk, and visit dozens of galleries and shops along the cobbled streets
- [NEW BEDFORD](#): Tour the historic City of New Bedford and enjoy the authentic charm of the nation's number 1 fishing fleet as well as experience New Bedford's shops, restaurants, and attractions including the Whaling Museum and Fort Taber Military Museum
