2024 CITIZEN OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Citizen of the Year should be someone who has made a lasting impact on the Falmouth Community. The following criteria should be considered when nominations are made.

All Entries must be received no later than February 29, 2024.

1. Nominees should live or work in Falmouth and civic activities should be centered in the Town of Falmouth.
2. Recognition will be given for leadership and performance only for work done above and beyond his/her paid profession.
3. The individual recognized does not need to be a member of the Falmouth Chamber of Commerce.
4. There are no requirements or restrictions relating to gender, race, religion, or ethnic background.
5. The nominee should have participated in a broad scope of activities over the course of more than one year. This is not an award for a single activity no matter how well it was executed.
6. The award will not be given posthumously.
